Justin Brooke

23.9.1871 p.832.

“We observe that the £100 shares of the Carnforth Hematite Iron Company (Limited), which was established some few years since by Messrs H.J. Walduck and Co., of Manchester, are at £100 premium per share, several transactions having taken place at this figure. The company’s last dividend was at the rate of 20 per cent. per annum”.

21.1.1871.
